

**Eligibility and Other Conditions for Entrance Test for Admission in
M.Phil/Ph.D (Academic year - 2010-11)**

M.Phil. - Environmental Plant Biology, English

Ph.D.- Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology and Biotechnology, Botany and Microbiology, Defense and Strategic Studies, Geology, Statistics, Environmental Sciences, Forestry, Horticulture, Sociology, Political science, Anthropology, Sanskrit, Hindi, English, Philosophy, Psychology, History and Archaeology, Economics, Geography, Drawing and Painting, Journalism and Mass communication, Tourism, Commerce, Extension Education, Plant Physiology

55 % Marks at Masters level (P.G.) in the concerned subject, or in a cognate or an allied/interdisciplinary subject, (for SC/ST 50 percent marks) or equivalent grade at the masters level or a degree equivalent to Master's degree recognized by the University or institution of higher learning recognized by the University in that regard, and fulfils other conditions of eligibility.

The test shall be followed by interview at Srinagar campus the date of which shall be notified by the University.

The NET/SLET/GATE/ and M.Phil. Qualified candidates, regularly appointed teachers of this University, Teacher Fellow (Under UGC Scheme) and sponsored candidates shall be exempted from the eligibility test for Ph.D.

Those appearing in the final year examinations can also apply subject to the condition that they will have to produce their final year result on or before the last date of admission.

Merely qualifying in entrance test does not guarantee admission in any programme as admission is subject to the availability of seats in different courses and fulfilling other conditions.

The application form duly completed must reach the University on or before July 3, 2010, along with a fee of Rs. 500/- (Five hundred) for General candidates and Rs. 250/ (Rs. Two hundred and fifty) for SC/ ST candidates through bank draft drawn in favour of **“Finance Officer, HNB Garhwal University” payable at Srinagar, Garhwal. Uttarakhand.**

Certified copies of testimonials in support of educational qualification, eligibility, date of birth, caste category must be attached with the form along with two self addressed stamped with Rs. 35/- each, envelope of the size of 28 cm X 12 cm.

Recent passport size coloured photograph should be pasted at the appropriate boxes in the form duly attested by the Head of the Institution last attended by the candidate or by any Gazetted Officer.

Duly completed applications should be sent to the Dean Student Welfare (DSW) HNB Garhwal University, Srinagar, Garhwal, Uttarakhand, 246174

The date of Entrance Test shall be conducted on Sunday, 18, **July, 2010** at Six Centers located in Srinagar- (Garhwal), Chennai, Dehradun, Delhi, Lucknow and Nainital. The University reserves the right to cancel any of the centres if required number of students are not available and can allot nearer centre for applicants of the centre cancelled.

Students shall have to take a written examination consisting of two parts – Part I: General Aptitude (50 marks) and Part II: Subject test, based on the P.G. syllabus of the concerned subject (100 marks). Total marks 150

The two parts shall contain 50 and 100 objective type questions and the Students shall be allowed a maximum of two hours time to complete the test

Students scoring more than 40% marks in the test shall be eligible for admission to the doctoral programme in the respective subject provided the candidate fulfills other conditions and availability of seats in the respective department.

The result of M.Phil/ Ph.D. entrance test shall be valid for admission for one academic year only.
